AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO PURCHASE AND INSTALL EDUCATIONAL COMPUTER SYSTEMS FOR THE BARELAS COMMUNITY CENTER LOCATED IN BERNALILLO COUNTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the local government division of the department of finance and administration for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 for the purpose of purchasing and installing educational computer systems for the Barelas community center located in Bernalillo county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
