RELATING TO THE PUBLIC PEACE, HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT OF AN AMERICAN INDIAN WOMEN'S CENTER.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the New Mexico office of Indian affairs for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 for the purpose of contracting for services for the planning and development of a Native American Indian women's center to assist Native American Indian women with education and career development while offering a safe and supportive environment for their children and families. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997
