A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION STUDY COMMITTEE TO ANALYZE
THE INFRASTRUCTURE NEEDS OF THE STATE'S PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND
RECOMMEND IMPROVEMENTS TO THE LEGISLATURE IN ALLOCATING
RESOURCES TO MEET THOSE NEEDS.

WHEREAS, public schools submitted requests to the public
school capital outlay council for more than one hundred twenty-
seven million dollars (\$127,000,000) worth of capital
improvements in fiscal year 1995; and

WHEREAS, the public school capital outlay council was able
to fund only a fraction of those requests; and

WHEREAS, some of the critical needs of our public schools
are illustrated by the school that is sinking in Pecos, a
collapsed roof on a school in Hatch and the use of rejected army
