A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE CHILDREN, YOUTH AND FAMILIES DEPARTMENT TO BUILD THE PROPOSED JUVENILE MAXIMUM SECURITY FACILITY AT THE NEW MEXICO BOYS' SCHOOL IN SPRINGER.

WHEREAS, the children, youth and families department is proposing to construct a new maximum security facility to restore justice and separate violent juvenile offenders from nonviolent offenders; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico boys' school at Springer already has the administrative and physical infrastructure in place and the personnel expertise to manage such a facility; and

WHEREAS, the expansion of the existing facility would cost the taxpayer less than a completely new facility somewhere else;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the children, youth and families department be requested to construct the new juvenile maximum security facility at the existing location of the New Mexico boys' school in Springer in Colfax county; and
