A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY TO INSPECT THE POJOAQUE PUEBLO SEWAGE TREATMENT FACILITY TO DETERMINE COMPLIANCE WITH THE CLEAN WATER ACT OF 1977.

WHEREAS, all New Mexico citizens, including those living on Native American pueblo and reservation lands, are concerned about the quality of life; and

WHEREAS, all New Mexico citizens, including those living on Native American pueblo and reservation lands, are concerned about clean air, clean water and public health; and

WHEREAS, environmental contaminants do not recognize political jurisdictional boundaries; and

WHEREAS, New Mexico is in a desert region, water is limited and clean water is a precious resource all are responsible for protecting; and

WHEREAS, the Pojoaque valley has severe problems from water contamination; and

WHEREAS, the United States environmental protection agency has primacy over clean water in the Pojoaque valley;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the United States environmental protection agency be requested to inspect the Pojoaque pueblo sewage treatment facility to determine whether it complies with the Clean Water Act of 1977; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the environmental protection agency determines that the Pojoaque pueblo sewage treatment system violates the Clean Water Act of 1977, that corrective action, consistent with tribal sovereignty, state sovereignty and federal law, be taken immediately; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the New Mexico legislative council be requested to direct the appropriate interim legislative committee to receive testimony on water quality in the Pojoaque valley and recommend appropriate action to the legislature by January 1, 1997; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the United States environmental protection agency and the New Mexico legislative council.
