# A JOINT MEMORIAL

EXPRESSING THE OPPOSITION OF THE LEGISLATURE TO THE GOVERNOR'S PLAN TO INCREASE TUITION AT NEW MEXICO'S INSTITUTIONS OF POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION.

WHEREAS, Governor Gary Johnson proposes to raise college tuition by eight percent; and

WHEREAS, this increase would be far more than the rate of inflation for the past several years; and

WHEREAS, too few New Mexicans can afford tuition as it is, and more, not fewer, New Mexicans need to obtain higher education in order for the state to enter the twenty-first century economically; and

WHEREAS, New Mexico is ranked forty-seventh among the fifty states in per capita income and our citizens depend on better more available education to improve their lives and the standing of New Mexico among the other states in academic and economic achievement; and

WHEREAS, cost cuts at educational institutions should not come at the expense of the people these institutions exist to serve; and

WHEREAS, recent advances in high technology offer the opportunity for colleges to reduce costs by teaching courses more efficiently through distance learning and other methods; and

WHEREAS, post-secondary institutions have other means of cutting costs such as consolidating boards of governors and departments, reducing administrative overhead and requiring more productivity from faculty;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the legislature oppose the governor's suggestion that boards of governors increase tuition; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that boards of governors be requested to disregard the governor's suggestion and hold the line on tuition if reduction of tuition is not possible; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the governor and to board of regents, governing board and community college board members of New Mexico post-secondary institutions.
