A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THAT THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION ASSIST HIGH SCHOOLS AND STUDENT ATHLETES IN MEETING NEW MEXICO COURSE REQUIREMENTS AND NATIONAL COLLEGIATE ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION INITIAL-ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS SO THAT STUDENT ATHLETES WILL NOT BE FORCED TO RELINQUISH SCHOLARSHIP ASSISTANCE.

WHEREAS, the national collegiate athletic association division I and II member institutions overwhelmingly endorsed the establishment of an initial-eligibility clearinghouse in 1993 to evaluate high school core courses in a consistent manner by trained, unbiased individuals and to review all other information required for initial-eligibility certification; and

WHEREAS, the national collegiate athletic association has established certain academic course requirements and procedures for nonstandard course approval by the clearinghouse academic

requirements committee that are based on documentation provided by high school principals or guidance personnel verifying that the nonstandard courses are qualitatively and quantitatively the same as regular academic courses; and

WHEREAS, student athletes may not receive appropriate or sufficient guidance on the clearinghouse initial-eligibility requirements and the interrelationships of high school courses and courses required by the clearinghouse; and

WHEREAS, there is evidence that New Mexico student athletes have encountered difficulties in meeting clearinghouse initialeligibility requirements, which puts their college admissions and scholarships in jeopardy; and

WHEREAS, information must be disseminated in a timely and appropriate manner to students, high school counselors, administrators and athletic personnel, colleges and universities, as well as the clearinghouse; and

WHEREAS, all students, including student athletes, must receive consistent, accurate and appropriate information to meet course, graduation and other necessary requirements; and

WHEREAS, the state board of education must prescribe courses of instruction, requirements for graduation and standards for all public schools, for private schools seeking state accreditation and for all the educational programs conducted in state institutions:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE

STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the state board of education communicate to school districts the student eligibility requirements for national collegiate athletic association athletic scholarships and that the state board of education encourage school counselors to share this information with students and parents in a timely manner; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the state board of education work with the New Mexico activities association to ensure that information on national collegiate athletic association eligibility requirements be included annually in New Mexico activities association mailings to member schools and that the national collegiate athletic association initial-eligibility requirements are the topic of appropriate New Mexico activities association state and regional meetings; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the state board of education inquire of the New Mexico national collegiate athletic association presidents commission members what problems students in New Mexico are encountering in meeting the initialeligibility requirements; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the state board of education communicate through the New Mexico national collegiate athletic association presidents commission regarding the state board of education alternative credit options and courses that correspond with national collegiate athletic association course requirements; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the president of the state board of education, the superintendent of public instruction, the New Mexico activities association and New Mexico national collegiate athletic association representatives for appropriate di stri buti on.
