DESIGNATING THE WEEK OF FEBRUARY 18 THROUGH 24 AS NEW MEXICO
SCIENCE BOWL WEEK.

WHEREAS, on February 24, 1996, thirty-four high school
teams from across the state will convene in Albuquerque to
compete in the science bowl; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico science bowl is a national event
aimed at providing a forum for high school students to showcase
their understanding of the observation, identification,
description, experimental investigation and theoretical
explanation of natural phenomena known to the general public as
the world of science, by competing in teams against other New
Mexico high schools; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico science bowl is sponsored by Los
