WHEREAS, "government of the people" means just that;

NOW. THEREFORE. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that each state department and agency that deals with these matters and, directly or indirectly, provides health, social and human services to consumers develop a consistent set of procedures to include consumers, consumer and advocacy organizations and service providers and their organizations in the decision-making process both for distribution of block grants and for regulating, establishing and interacting with managed care systems; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the secretaries of health, human services and children, youth and families; the director of the state agency on aging; the commission for deaf and hard-of-hearing persons; the commission for the blind; the New Mexico health policy commission; the governor's committee on concerns of the handicapped; and the governor; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the office of the governor be requested to move expeditiously to assure that the provisions of this memorial are implemented to permit statewide community meetings and the participation of the various citizens and organizations enumerated and report to both the interim
