A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING SELECTION OF A COMMITTEE OF BANKING AND INSURANCE INDUSTRY REPRESENTATIVES TO STUDY THE ISSUE OF INSURANCE SALES BY FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS AND REPORT ITS FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING CHANGES IN THE NEW MEXICO INSURANCE CODE AND THE BANKING ACT TO THE FIRST SESSION OF THE FORTY-THIRD LEGISLATURE.

WHEREAS, financial institutions are convinced that to continue to be competitive it is essential to expand into financial services areas from which they traditionally have been restricted; and

WHEREAS, there have been consistent objections to financial institution expansion into the insurance field; and

WHEREAS, conflicting views have resulted in a patchwork of federal and state statutes and regulations concerning the

insurance activities in which bank holding companies and banks may engage; and

WHEREAS, federal reserve board and comptroller of the currency interpretations expanding the insurance powers of financial institutions have been met by litigation;

NOW. THEREFORE. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the director of the financial institutions division of the regulation and licensing department and the superintendent of insurance select a committee of banking and insurance industry representatives to study issues concerning insurance sales by financial institutions and to report its findings and recommendations regarding changes in the New Mexico Insurance Code and the Banking Act to the first session of the forty-third legislature; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be transmitted to the director of the financial institutions division of the regulation and licensing department and the superintendent of insurance.
