A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE CHILDREN, YOUTH AND FAMILIES DEPARTMENT TO
PROCEED WITH THE DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION AND FINANCING OF A FIFTY-
BED SECURE JUVENILE DETENTION FACILITY IN TUCUMCARI.

WHEREAS, the increase in violent crimes committed by
juvenile offenders has highlighted the need for new facilities
to house these offenders; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico boys' school, the New Mexico girls'
school and the youth diagnostic and development center are all
overcrowded; and

WHEREAS, in its "restoring justice" plan, the children,
youth and families department has identified the need for a
secure juvenile detention facility; and

WHEREAS, the city of Tucumcari has established a mayor's
task force for correctional facilities development and that task

1 force has held public hearings on the question of locating a
2 secure juvenile facility in Tucumcari; and

3 WHEREAS, during the public hearings, the testimony
4 indicated that the people of Tucumcari widely support the idea
5 of locating a secure juvenile detention facility in their
6 community; and

7 WHEREAS, the city of Tucumcari possesses the infrastructure
8 and labor force required to operate a secure juvenile detention
9 facility;

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE
11 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the children, youth and families
12 department be requested to issue a request for proposals for the
13 design, construction and financing of a fifty-bed secure
14 juvenile detention facility in the city of Tucumcari; and

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be
16 transmitted to the governor, the secretary of children, youth
17 and families and the mayor of Tucumcari.
