16	scenic Moreno valley of northern New Mexico by the owner, the CS

18	WHEREAS, Eagle Nest lake has been leased by the state game
19	commission for public recreational use at various times in the
20	past and is presently leased by the commission for this purpose,
21	the lease to expire in the year 2000; and
22	WHEREAS, Eagle Nest lake is one of the most productive
23	trout fisheries in the United States and is the most productive
24	large cold-water lake fishery in the state; and
25	WHEREAS, Eagle Nest lake is fished on over eighty-one

thousand fisherman days annually by individuals who spend significantly in the community in pursuit of their sport; and

WHEREAS, public use of Eagle Nest lake provides tremendous economic and recreational benefits to the villages of Eagle Nest and Angel Fire, the city of Taos, Colfax and Taos counties and the state; and

WHEREAS, the owners of Eagle Nest lake have expressed a willingness to discuss options for state acquisition of the lake and surrounding property so that it will remain in public use and in a pristine condition in perpetuity;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New Mexico legislative council be requested to direct the appropriate interim committee to meet with the owners and assess the feasibility of acquiring Eagle Nest lake and the surrounding property for public use, including identification of possible properties available for exchange; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the appropriate interim committee report its findings and make recommendations to the New Mexico legislative council by December 1, 1996; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the New Mexico legislative council.
