A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE NEW MEXICO CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION TO SEEK
FEDERAL FUNDS FOR THE SHIPROCK MULTIPURPOSE CENTER IN SAN JUAN
COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the Shiprock community in San Juan county has
pursued with substantial energy and commitment the need for
construction of a multipurpose center to serve critical needs of
the Shiprock community, including in particular the very young
and very old; and

WHEREAS, the state of New Mexico has recognized the
important needs of the Shiprock community and appropriated five
hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$560,000) for planning, design,
construction and equipment for the Shiprock multipurpose center;
and

WHEREAS, the Navajo nation has similarly recognized the

2 hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for planning, design,
3 construction and equipment for the Shiprock multipurpose center;

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE
5 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the federal government be requested to
6 pursue funding options that might be available to contribute
7 five million dollars (\$5,000,000) to help complete construction
8 of the Shiprock multipurpose center; and

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the New Mexico congressional
10 delegation be urged to contact all appropriate federal officials
11 to pursue funding options that might be available from the
12 federal government to contribute five million dollars
13 (\$5,000,000) to the construction of the Shiprock multipurpose
14 center; and

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be sent
16 to all members of the New Mexico congressional delegation.
