NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN that the following new proposed Joint Rule 11-1 be adopted to read:

"SMOKING IN STATE CAPITOL (11-1)

Smoking is prohibited in the state capitol except for legislators in a legislator's office if the office is well-ventilated and if a legislator who shares the office does not object. "
