16	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	Section 1. It is proposed to amend Article 4, Section 10
18	of the constitution of New Mexico to read:
19	"Each member of the legislature shall receive:
20	A. as per diem expense the sum of not more than
21	seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) for each day's attendance during
22	each session, as provided by law, and twenty-five cents (\$.25)
23	for each mile traveled in going to and returning from the seat
24	of government by the usual traveled route, once each session as
25	defined by Article 4, Section 5 of this constitution;

7	Section 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall
8	be submitted to the people for their approval or rejection at
9	the next general election or at any special election prior to
10	that date which may be called for that purpose.
