A MEMORIAL

RECOGNIZING THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF JUSTICE STANLEY F. FROST TO NEW
MEXICO.

WHEREAS, Justice Stanley F. Frost has served as a member of
the New Mexico supreme court since 1991 and as a district court
judge for nineteen years; and

WHEREAS, Justice Frost received his bachelor's degree from
New Mexico highlands university and his law degree from George
Washington university and, after admission to the bar in 1967,
he practiced law in Tucumcari; and

WHEREAS, as district judge of the tenth judicial district,
he was highly regarded throughout the state, being asked to
preside over cases in twenty-four counties where local judges
had been disqualified or recused; and
