AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A NEEDS ASSESSMENT OF ALZHEIMER'S
DISEASE AND RELATED DISORDERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred fifty thousand
dollars (\$150,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
department of health for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for the
purpose of providing or contracting for an assessment of both
the number of persons who have Alzheimer's disease or dementia-
related disorders and the existing services and needs of such
persons and their families and caregivers. Any unexpended or
unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998
shall revert to the general fund.
