AN ACT

RELATING TO POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION; AMENDING SECTIONS OF THE  
NMSA 1978 TO PROVIDE FOR EMPLOYEE INTEREST IN CONTRACTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 21-1-17 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1889,  
Chapter 138, Section 68, as amended) is amended to read:

"21-1-17. INTEREST IN CONTRACTS BY BOARD MEMBERS OR  
EMPLOYEES PROHIBITED. --No employee or member of a board of  
regents of any state educational institution shall have any  
direct or indirect financial interest in any contract for  
building or improving any of that state educational institution  
or for the furnishing of supplies or services to that  
institution except as permitted pursuant to the University  
Research Park Act and except that an employee may have an  
interest if the contract or transaction is consistent with the

1 Governmental Conduct Act and is awarded pursuant to the  
2 Procurement Code. "

3 Section 2. Section 21-1-35 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1923,  
4 Chapter 148, Section 1415, as amended) is amended to read:

5 "21-1-35. SALES BY BOARDS, OFFICERS OR EMPLOYEES  
6 PROHIBITED--PARTIES TO CONTRACTS RECEIVING COMMISSION OR  
7 PROFIT--PENALTY.--No board of regents of a state educational  
8 institution, no member of a board and no school official or  
9 teacher, either directly or indirectly, shall sell to any state  
10 educational institution that he is connected with by reason of  
11 being a member of a board of regents of a state educational  
12 institution or to any school official or teacher, any school  
13 books, school furniture, equipment, apparatus or any other kind  
14 of school supplies, sell property insurance or life insurance to  
15 any employee of that state educational institution or do any  
16 work under contract, nor shall any such board or members thereof  
17 or school officers or teachers receive any commission or profit  
18 on account thereof, and all such persons are prohibited from  
19 being parties directly or indirectly to any such contract or  
20 transaction; provided that the provisions of this section shall  
21 not apply to contracts entered into pursuant to the provisions  
22 of the University Research Park Act or to contracts or  
23 transactions in which employees have an interest if the contract  
24 or transaction is consistent with the Governmental Conduct Act  
25 and is awarded pursuant to the Procurement Code Any person

1 violating the provisions of this section shall be fined not  
2 exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or imprisoned not  
3 exceeding one year in the penitentiary of New Mexico or be fined  
4 and imprisoned as set forth in this section in the discretion of
