AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; CHANGING THE PURPOSE OF A
GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION; DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. GENERAL FUND--CHANGE OF PURPOSE--

APPROPRIATION.--The balance of the proceeds from the general
fund appropriation to the local government division of the
department of finance and administration for the acquisition of
land to be used as the site of a community fire station at
Chamisal in Taos county pursuant to Paragraph (30) of Subsection
B of Section 49 of Chapter 148 of Laws 1994 and as extended
pursuant to Laws 1995, Chapter 218, Section 26 shall not be
expended for that purpose but is reauthorized and appropriated
to the local government division of the department of finance

1 and administration to plan or construct a fire substation in
2 Chamisal in Taos county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance
3 remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the
4 general fund.

5 Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public
6 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
