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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
18	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS
19	A. The state board of finance may issue and sell
20	severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding
21	Act in an amount not exceeding one million two hundred seventeen
22	thousand three hundred dollars ( $\$1, 217, 300$ ) when the local
23	government division of the department of finance and
24	administration certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds.
25	The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale

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1 of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been 2 developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the 3 project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The 4 state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps 5 6 necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are 7 amended. appropriated to the local government division of the department 8 9 of finance and administration in the following amounts for the 10 following purposes, all in the town of Carrizozo in Lincoln 11 county:

(1) six hundred thirteen thousand dollars
(\$613,000) for engineering and architectural studies,
construction and improvements necessary to construct a new
municipal building or renovate the existing municipal building;

(2) twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) topurchase a computer system;

(3) one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to improve the golf course by the purchase and installation of an automated sprinkler system;

(4) two hundred twenty-five thousand dollars(\$225,000) to purchase heavy equipment for the city yard;

(5) one hundred fourteen thousand three hundred dollars (\$114,300) to improve, renovate and expand the swimming pool; to improve the swimming pool facility to comply with the

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1 American Disabilities Act of 1990; and to purchase and install a heating system for the swimming pool; 2 (6) twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) for 3 engineering and architectural studies and construction to 4 renovate the existing Carrizozo municipal airport on Eighth 5 6 street and to comply with the American Disabilities Act of 1990; 7 and (7) one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars 8 9 (\$125,000) to purchase heavy equipment for the town yard. 10 **B**. If the local government division of the department of finance and administration has not certified the 11 12 need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 13 1999, the authorization provided in this section shall be void. 14 Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining from the 15 proceeds of severance tax bonds issued pursuant to Subsection A 16 of this section at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to 17 the severance tax bonding fund. 18 Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public 19 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately. - 3 -20 21 22 23 24 25

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
