AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO PROVIDE SERVICES FOR LOW-INCOME
PERSONS WITH MENTAL ILLNESSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION--SERVICES FOR THE MENTALLY ILL.--

Two million sixty thousand dollars (\$2,060,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the department of health for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for the purpose of providing services for mentally ill persons, including community crisis stabilization diversion beds; jail diversion services and infrastructure; medication and drug formulary enhancement; and residential support and quality outcome services. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
