1 right of every person to be secure and protected from intimidation and physical harm caused by the criminal activities 2 of violent groups and individuals. The legislature also finds 3 that the citizens of New Mexico are concerned about the increase 4 in criminal activity that can be attributed to criminal street 5 6 This criminal activity presents a clear and present gangs. 7 danger to public safety and is not the type of activity that is protected by the constitution of the United States or the 8 9 constitution of the state of New Mexico.

B. The purpose of the Street Gang Enforcement and Prevention Act is not to interfere with constitutionally protected rights of freedom of speech and freedom of association. Rather, the purpose of the Street Gang Enforcement and Prevention Act is to deter and punish criminal activity engaged in by individuals involved in criminal street gangs."

Section 3. A new section of the Criminal Code is enacted to read:

"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] DEFINITIONS.--As used in the Street Gang Enforcement and Prevention Act:

A. "criminal street gang" means an organization, association or group of three or more persons:

(1) that has a common name or a common identifying sign or symbol; and

(2) whose members engage in a pattern of criminal gang activity; and

"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] PARTICIPATION IN A CRIMINAL STREET GANG--ALTERATION OF BASIC SENTENCE--SUSPENSION AND DEFERRAL LIMITED.--

A. When a separate finding of fact by the court or jury shows that a noncapital felony was committed by an individual in association with a criminal street gang with the specific intent to assist the criminal street gang with a pattern of criminal gang activity, the basic sentence of imprisonment prescribed for the offense in Section 31-18-15 NMSA 1978 shall be increased by two years. The sentence imposed pursuant to this subsection shall be the first two years served and shall not be suspended, deferred or conditionally discharged; provided, that when the offender is a serious youthful offender or a youthful offender, the sentence imposed pursuant to this subsection may be increased by two years.

B. For a second or subsequent noncapital felony committed by an individual in association with a criminal street gang with the specific intent to assist the criminal street gang with a pattern of criminal gang activity, the basic sentence of imprisonment prescribed for the offense in Section 31-18-15 NMSA 1978 shall be increased by four years. The sentence imposed pursuant to this subsection shall be the first four years served and shall not be suspended, deferred or conditionally discharged; provided, that when the offender is a serious youthful offender or a youthful offender, the sentence imposed pursuant to this subsection may be increased by four years.
