AN ACT

RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF CREDIT FOR AN AEROSPACE MANUFACTURING FACILITY IN TORRANCE COUNTY; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. STANDBY LETTER OF CREDIT. -- The department of finance and administration may issue a standby letter of credit in an amount not exceeding five hundred million dollars (\$500,000,000) for the purpose of providing collateral for the costs of constructing facilities and establishing corporate headquarters for the IOSTAR-INTRASPACE corporation and providing the capability for design, development and initial operations of the IOSTAR SPACE TV6 to be located in Torrance county when the department certifies that the following conditions have been met:

- A. the department of finance and administration finds that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance of the standby letter of credit and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time;
- B. the parent corporation, IOSTAR, and the INTRASPACE corporation agree to locate its headquarters in New Mexico;
- C. the standby letter of credit will be issued in full conformance with banking laws;
- D. the contract that the standby letter of credit guarantees will be structured to eliminate any possibility of default by IOSTAR or INTRASPACE corporation and will preclude any default placing the state of New Mexico at financial risk;
- E. the department of finance and administration may issue the standby letter of credit for no more than a four-year duration through a major bank selected by the state of New Mexico;
- F. the standby letter of credit is issued to secure funding from third parties for development of IOSTAR and INTRASPACE corporation, a space TV6 manufacturing and advanced space transportation and satellite telecommunications company; and
- G. the standby letter of credit shall not be cash-redeemable by the corporation or any other entity.
 - Section 2. EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public

peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
