AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR
CONSTRUCTION OF GUADALUPE PARK IN THE CITY OF ARTESIA IN EDDY
COUNTY; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION-- GUADALUPE PARK. -- Three hundred
twenty-nine thousand dollars (\$329,000) is appropriated from the
general fund to the local government division of the department
of finance and administration for expenditure in fiscal years
1997 and 1998 for the purpose of constructing the Guadalupe park
in the city of Artesia in Eddy county. Any unexpended or
unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998
shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public
peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
