AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR STATE CAPITAL PLANNING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO: Section 1. APPROPRIATIONS. --

A. The following amounts are appropriated from the general fund to the legislative council service for expenditure in fiscal years 1999 and 2000 for the capitol buildings planning commission to prepare or contract for state capital planning studies as follows:

- (1) one hundred fifty thousand dollars(\$150,000) for a repair and replacement study, including:
- (a) physical inspection of statebuildings in the capital;
- $\mbox{(b)} \quad \mbox{inventory and evaluation of} \\ \mbox{building systems; and} \quad \mbox{}$
- $\mbox{(c)} \quad \mbox{development of a repair and} \\ \mbox{replacement fund; and} \\$
- (\$150,000) for a master plan integrating city and county general plan provisions that affect state buildings in Santa Fe, including:
- $\hbox{ (a) inventory of state buildings and } \\ land in the capital;$
 - (b) master site development plans of

the various state building complexes and other state-owned property;

- (c) a locale and government growth impact study that identifies master plan alternatives;
- (d) location assignment criteria for state agencies and employees; and
- $\mbox{(e)} \quad \mbox{other components the capitol} \\ \mbox{buildings planning commission deems necessary}.$
- B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the general fund.
