AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECRUITING, EMPLOYING, TRAINING AND EQUIPPING ADDITIONAL STATE POLICE OFFICERS; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF SEVERANCE TAX BONDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF EQUIPPING ADDITIONAL STATE POLICE OFFICERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Two million eight hundred thousand dollars (\$2,800,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the department of public safety for expenditure in fiscal year 1999 for the purpose of recruiting, employing, training and equipping fifty additional state police officers. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--PURPOSE FOR WHICH

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1 ISSUED-- APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS. --The state board of finance
2 may issue and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the
3 Severance Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding five
4 million eight hundred thousand dollars (\$5,800,000) when the
5 department of public safety certifies the need for the
6 issuance of the bonds. The state board of finance shall
7 schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most
8 expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by
9 the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to
10 justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to
11 contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance
12 shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply
13 with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The
14 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the
15 department of public safety for the purpose of equipping forty
16 additional state police officers each fiscal year during
17 fiscal years 2000 through 2002. Any unexpended or
18 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2002
19 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. If the
20 department of public safety has not certified the need for the
21 issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 2001, the
22 authorization provided in this section shall be void.

Amendment sponsored by Senator
