1 percent of grade midpoint and based on the employee's rating 2 and compa-ratio is authorized. This increase includes 3 providing annualized variable pay anniversary lump-sum 4 payments to eligible classified employees whose salaries equal or exceed their salary grade maximums. Salary increases shall 5 be effective the first full pay period following the 6 7 employee's anniversary date. The department of finance and administration shall distribute a sufficient amount to each 8 9 agency to provide the appropriate increase for those employees 10 whose salaries are received as a result of the general fund 11 appropriations in the General Appropriation Act of 1998.
