AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION; CREATING THE EXTENDED LEARNING STUDY COMMITTEE; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. EXTENDED LEARNING STUDY COMMITTEE. --

A. The "extended learning study committee" is created. The committee shall consist of:

- (1) the chairmen of the commission on higher education and the state board of education or their designees, who shall serve as co-chairmen of the committee;
- (2) one representative from the New Mexico association of community colleges;
- (3) one representative from the public fouryear institutions appointed by the council of presidents;
 - (4) the state librarian:

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- (5) the superintendent of public instruction;
- (6) two representatives appointed by the governor from the communications industry;
- (7) two representatives from the business community, one appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives and one appointed by the president pro tempore of the senate;
- (8) one representative from the national guard of New Mexico;
 - (9) the chief information officer;
- (10) one representative from the associated students of the universities of New Mexico; and
- (11) one representative from the superintendents association.
- B. The committee shall advise the commission on higher education and public post-secondary educational institutions on the development of a plan to establish an extended learning network that may include public and private educational institutions, libraries, medical facilities, existing virtual universities, other public facilities and private sector entities that donate their facilities and resources for extended learning services.
- C. The committee shall develop an extended learning plan that includes a timetable with phase-in options, cost projections, strategies for addressing professional

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development needs and recommendations to the legislature and the governor for implementing the plan.

- D. The commission on higher education and the state board of education shall jointly provide staff support and administrative services to the committee.
- E. The committee shall report its findings and recommendations to the governor and to the legislature by December 1, 1998.
- F. Members of the extended learning study committee who are not state employees shall be paid per diem and mileage as provided in the Per Diem and Mileage Act and shall receive no other compensation, perquisite or allowance.

Section 2. APPROPRIATION. -- Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the commission on higher education for expenditure in fiscal years 1998 and 1999 for the purpose of supporting the work of the extended learning study committee. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 3. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
