AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREARMS; PROHIBITING CERTAIN ACTIONS IN CONNECTION WITH REGISTRATION OF FIREARMS PURSUANT TO FEDERAL BRADY ACT; PROHIBITING COLLECTION OF FEES IN CONNECTION WITH IMPLEMENTATION OF FEDERAL BRADY ACT; IMPOSING PENALTIES; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. SHORT TITLE.--This act may be cited as the "Firearms Tax Cut and Privacy Act".

Section 2. PROHIBITION OF CERTAIN ACTIONS IN CONNECTION WITH REGISTRATION OF FIREARMS. -- A person who by virtue of his official position or his employment gains possession of information concerning an individual because of the operation of Public Law 103-159, commonly referred to as the "Brady Act", and communicates that information to any person not

legally entitled to receive it, or fails to destroy the information within forty-eight hours of possession of it unless retention is specifically required by federal law, is guilty of a felony and shall be imprisoned for not more than five years or fined not more than one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000), or both.

Section 3. PROHIBITION OF CHARGING OF FEES BY STATE

OFFICER OR AGENCY FOR TAKING ACTION TO IMPLEMENT PUBLIC LAW

103-159.--A state officer, agency or employee shall not charge or collect any fee in connection with an action taken to implement Public Law 103-159, commonly known as the "Brady Act".

Section 4. EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.

AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREARMS; PROHIBITING ACCEPTANCE OF FEDERAL FUNDS IF CONDITIONED UPON STATE PARTICIPATION IN NATIONAL FIREARM REGISTRATION DATABASE: DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. PROHIBITION OF PARTICIPATION IN FIREARMS REGISTRATION DATABASE. -- No state agency, board or institution and no political subdivision of the state or a subdivision's agencies, boards or institutions shall accept grants or loans of federal funds that are conditioned upon the state or local entity's participation in creation or maintenance of a national firearm registration database.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
