MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO PROVIDE STATEWIDE INDEPENDENT LIVING SERVICES FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the vocational rehabilitation division of the state department of public education for expenditure in fiscal year 1999 to expand consumer-controlled community-based independent living services as defined by the federal Rehabilitation Act of 1973, including peer counseling, information and referral, systems advocacy, life-skills training and other related services for people with disabilities in priority areas of the state as determined by the statewide independent living council. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of
