AN ACT

RELATING TO TAXATION; AUTHORIZING DISTRIBUTION OF A PORTION OF THE LIQUOR EXCISE TAX TO THE STATE HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONDUCTING ANTI-DWI MEDIA CAMPAIGNS; AMENDING AND ENACTING SECTIONS OF THE NMSA 1978.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. [NEW MATERIAL] STATE HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT-- TRAFFIC SAFETY BUREAU-- ANTI-DWI CAMPAIGN.--The traffic safety bureau of the state highway and transportation department shall organize and conduct an anti-DWI traffic safety media campaign. Any distribution of the liquor excise tax received by the department pursuant to Subsection B of Section 7-1-6.40 NMSA 1978 shall be utilized for the purpose of financing anti-DWI traffic safety media campaigns.

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1 Section 2. Section 7-1-6. 40 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1997,
2 Chapter 182, Section 1), which is to become effective July 1,
3 1998, is amended to read:

4 "7-1-6. 40. DISTRIBUTION-- [~~LOCAL DWI GRANT FUND~~] LIQUOR
5 EXCISE TAX.--A distribution pursuant to Section 7-1-6. 1 NMSA
6 1978 shall be made to:

7 A. the local DWI grant fund in an amount equal to
8 twenty-seven and two-tenths percent of the net receipts
9 attributable to the liquor excise tax; and

10 B. the traffic safety bureau of the state highway
11 and transportation department in an amount equal to three
12 percent of the net receipts attributable to the liquor excise
13 tax for the purpose of conducting anti-DWI media campaigns . "

14 Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE--The effective date of the
15 provisions of this act is July 1, 1998.
