AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE
DISTRICT ATTORNEYS FOR THE PURPOSE OF HIRING ADDITIONAL STAFF
AND PURCHASING COMPUTER EQUIPMENT FOR DISTRICT ATTORNEYS'
OFFICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --

A. Three hundred ninety-one thousand seven hundred
eighty-five dollars (\$391,785) is appropriated from the
general fund to the administrative office of the district
attorneys for expenditure in fiscal year 1999 for the purpose
of hiring additional staff and purchasing computer equipment
for district attorneys' offices. The additional staff and
computer equipment shall be used to enter data into the
district attorneys' case management system. The appropriation

1 shall be distributed by the administrative office of the
2 district attorneys to the following district attorneys'
3 offices in the following amounts and for the following
4 purposes:

8 computer equipment;

18 dollars (\$26,119) to the fourth judicial district attorney's
19 office for one permanent full-time equivalent position and
20 computer equipment;

9 attorney's office for one permanent full-time equivalent
10 position and computer equipment.

11 B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance
12 remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the
13 general fund.
