AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE SUPPORT OF VARIOUS SENIOR CITIZEN PROGRAMS STATEWIDE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Two million eight hundred fifty-nine thousand six hundred fifty-four dollars (\$2,859,654) is appropriated from the general fund to the state agency on aging for expenditure in fiscal year 1999 for the purpose of providing various services for senior citizens statewide, including community services for seniors at risk of institutionalization such as adult daycare, Alzheimer education and assistance, case management, meals on wheels, home health and homemaker services, personal and respite care and senior companion and transportation programs. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of
