AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF SEVERANCE TAX BONDS FOR INFRASTRUCTURE RENOVATION AND OTHER CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS ON THE CAMPUSES OF STATE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--AUTHORIZATIONS--APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS.--

A. The state board of finance may issue and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding Act in an amount not to exceed the total of the amounts authorized for purposes specified in Sections 2 through 14 of this act. The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by

the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. Proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated for the purposes specified in Sections 2 through 14 of this act.

- B. The agencies named in Sections 2 through 14 of this act shall certify to the state board of finance when the money from the proceeds of the severance tax bonds authorized in this section is needed for the purposes specified in the applicable section of this act.
- C. If the specified agency has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 2000, the authorization provided in this act shall be void.
- D. Unless otherwise specified in this act, any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining from the proceeds of severance tax bonds issued pursuant to Sections 2 through 14 of this act at the end of fiscal year 2001 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund.

Section 2. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the board of regents of the university of New Mexico that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, four million fifty thousand

dollars (\$4,050,000) is appropriated to the board of regents of the university of New Mexico for the purpose of funding utility distribution system expansion, a domestic water system, access roads and street repairs on the main campus of the university of New Mexico located in Bernalillo county.

Section 3. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--BOARD OF REGENTS OF EASTERN NEW MEXICO UNIVERSITY--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the board of regents of eastern New Mexico university that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, one million seven hundred fifty-two thousand dollars (\$1,752,000) is appropriated to the board of regents of eastern New Mexico university for the purpose of funding infrastructure renewal and information systems infrastructure at the main and branch campuses of eastern New Mexico university.

MEXICO HIGHLANDS UNIVERSITY--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the board of regents of New Mexico highlands university that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, one million two hundred forty-seven thousand dollars (\$1,247,000) is appropriated to the board of regents of New Mexico highlands university for the purpose of funding infrastructure improvements and information systems infrastructure on the campus of New Mexico highlands university located in San

Miguel county.

Section 5. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE NEW MEXICO INSTITUTE OF MINING AND TECHNOLOGY--PURPOSE. -Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the board of regents of the New Mexico institute of mining and technology that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, one million one hundred ninety-seven thousand dollars (\$1,197,000) is appropriated to the board of regents of the New Mexico institute of mining and technology for the purpose of funding infrastructure renovation and expansion and information systems infrastructure on the campus of the New Mexico institute of mining and technology located in Socorro county.

Section 6. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--BOARD OF REGENTS OF NEW MEXICO STATE UNIVERSITY--PURPOSES.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the board of regents of New Mexico state university that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are appropriated to the board of regents of New Mexico state university for the following purposes:

A. one million four hundred thousand dollars
(\$1,400,000) for the purpose of funding the upgrade and
expansion of campus utility infrastructure on the main campus
of New Mexico state university located in Dona Ana county;

B. one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000)

for the purpose of funding infrastructure renewal on the Alamogordo campus of New Mexico state university located in Otero county;

- C. one hundred twelve thousand five hundred dollars (\$112,500) for the purpose of funding infrastructure renewal on the Dona Ana campus of New Mexico state university located in Dona Ana county;
- D. two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the purpose of funding infrastructure renewal on the Carlsbad campus of New Mexico state university located in Eddy county; and
- E. two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the purpose of funding infrastructure renewal on the Grants campus of New Mexico state university located in Cibola county.

Section 7. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--BOARD OF REGENTS OF
WESTERN NEW MEXICO UNIVERSITY--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the
provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the
board of regents of western New Mexico university that the
need exists for the issuance of the bonds, one million two
hundred forty-seven thousand dollars (\$1,247,000) is
appropriated to the board of regents of western New Mexico
university for the purpose of funding infrastructure
renovation and expansion and information systems
infrastructure on the western New Mexico university campus

located in Grant county.

Section 8. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--BOARD OF REGENTS OF NORTHERN NEW MEXICO STATE SCHOOL--PURPOSES.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the board of regents of northern New Mexico state school that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are appropriated to the board of regents of northern New Mexico state school for the following purposes:

A. four hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$450,000) for the purpose of funding site drainage improvements on the Espanola campus of northern New Mexico state school located in Rio Arriba county; and

B. two hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$220,000) for the purpose of funding phase II infrastructure for sewer and water improvements on the El Rito campus of northern New Mexico state school located in Rio Arriba county.

Section 9. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD OF CLOVIS COMMUNITY COLLEGE--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the community college board of Clovis community college that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, six hundred sixty-three thousand seven hundred fifty dollars (\$663,750) is appropriated to the community college board of Clovis community college for the purpose of funding infrastructure renovation, access roads and parking lots on the Clovis

community college campus located in Curry county.

Section 10. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--GOVERNING BOARD OF NEW MEXICO JUNIOR COLLEGE--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the governing board of New Mexico junior college that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) is appropriated to the governing board of New Mexico junior college for the purpose of funding infrastructure improvements on the campus of New Mexico junior college located in Lea county.

Section 11. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--GOVERNING BOARD OF SAN JUAN COLLEGE--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the governing board of San Juan college that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, six hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$650,000) is appropriated to the governing board of San Juan college for the purpose of funding mechanical system upgrades on the campus of San Juan college located in San Juan county.

Section 12. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--BOARD OF REGENTS OF NEW MEXICO MILITARY INSTITUTE--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this at, upon certification by the board of regents of New Mexico military institute that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, one million one hundred seventy-seven thousand dollars (\$1,177,000) is appropriated to the board of regents of New Mexico military

institute for the purpose of funding general sewer and water improvements on the campus of New Mexico military institute located in Chaves county.

Section 13. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--BOARD OF REGENTS OF NEW MEXICO SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the board of regents of New Mexico school for the deaf that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) is appropriated to the board of regents of New Mexico school for the deaf for the purpose of funding infrastructure improvements on the campus of New Mexico school for the deaf located in Santa Fe county.

Section 14. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--GOVERNING BOARD OF LUNA VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL INSTITUTE--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the governing board of Luna vocational-technical institute that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) is appropriated to the governing board of Luna vocational-technical institute for the purpose of funding general improvements on the campus of Luna vocational-technical institute located in San Miguel county.

Section 15. EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
