BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

A. Eighty-five thousand dollars (\$85,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the department of public safety for expenditure in fiscal year 1999 to contract for a comprehensive statewide study of DWI in New Mexico. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of

fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 1.

B. The comprehensive study shall seek to determine the point of sale of alcoholic beverages consumed immediately prior to arrest for DWI. For purposes of the study, the point of sale shall be classified by the types of sellers and

locations of sale of alcoholic beverages, such as convenience stores, grocery stores, restaurants, bars, package stores and drive-up windows.

C. The findings and recommendations from the comprehensive statewide DWI study shall be reported to the first session of the forty-fifth legislature.
