RELATING TO THE ENVIRONMENT; REQUIRING THAT GASOLINE
DISTRIBUTORS BE LICENSED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT;
IMPOSING LICENSE FEES: MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. A new section of the Ground Water Protection Act is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] GASOLINE DISTRIBUTORS--ENVIRONMENTAL
LICENSE--LICENSE FEE. --

A. Any person registered as a distributor under the provisions of the Gasoline Tax Act shall obtain an environmental license from the department. The fee for the environmental license is based on the total gallons received less total gallons deducted pursuant to the Gasoline Tax Act during the previous calendar year and is due on or before

April 1 of each year. The fee shall be determined by the following schedule:

250,000 gallons	1,000,000 gallons	\$7, 500. 00

5, 000, 000 and over		\$50, 000. 00.

B. The department shall collect the environmental license fees and distribute fifty percent of the revenue received to the corrective action fund and fifty percent to the state road fund."

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. -- The effective date of the provisions of this act is January 1, 1999.
