AN ACT

FOR THE LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION STUDY COMMITTEE

RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL OUTLAY; PROVIDING FOR A STUDY OF PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL OUTLAY FACILITIES AND INFRASTRUCTURE; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

STUDY--APPROPRIATION. --Section 1.

The public school capital outlay council shall conduct a comprehensive study of public school capital outlay needs statewide. The study shall include development of guidelines and standards; an inventory and assessment of school facilities and infrastructure; cost estimates for repair, renovation and modernization of existing facilities; and an estimate of future facility needs. The study shall assess the equity and efficiency of current state and local

processes used to fund public school facilities and recommend an equitable and efficient method to meet public school capital outlay needs. A progress report shall be presented to the legislative education study committee and the legislative finance committee by September 1, 1998 and the final report by December 31, 1998.

B. Four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state department of public education for expenditure in fiscal years 1998 and 1999 for the purpose of conducting a study of public school capital outlay facilities and infrastructure. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
