MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A COMMUNITY-BASED ANTI-DRUG PROGRAM IN BERNALILLO COUNTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the department of public safety for expenditure in fiscal year 1999 for the purpose of contracting with a nonprofit organization to operate a community-based anti-drug program in Bernalillo county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund.
