AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE DISTRICT ATTORNEYS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING AND EXPANDING DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROGRAMS IN DISTRICT ATTORNEYS' OFFICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Two million two hundred seven thousand eight hundred ninety-seven dollars (\$2,207,897) is appropriated from the general fund to the administrative office of the district attorneys for expenditure in fiscal year 1999 for the purpose of hiring additional staff to establish and expand domestic violence programs in district attorneys' offices. The appropriation shall be distributed by the administrative office of the district attorneys to the following district attorneys' offices in the following amounts
