MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO FUND NAVAJO TRADITIONAL DISPUTE RESOLUTION LIAISONS FOR THE PEACEMAKER COURT IN SHIPROCK IN SAN JUAN COUNTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

APPROPRIATION. -- Eighty thousand dollars Section 1. (\$80,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the New Mexico office of Indian affairs for expenditure in fiscal year 1999 for the purpose of contracting for traditional dispute resolution liaisons to provide peacemaker court services in the Shiprock area of the Navajo Nation. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund.
