MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A TRIBAL-STATE COMMUNITY-BASED EDUCATION PROJECT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the New Mexico office of Indian affairs for expenditure in fiscal year 1999 for the purpose of funding a project developed through a partnership between the state and a pueblo education consortium to improve the education of Indian students. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund.
