AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION; ESTABLISHING A PROGRAM PROVIDING STUDENTS AN OPPORTUNITY TO OBSERVE AND PARTICIPATE IN THE LEGISLATIVE PROCESS; ENACTING THE STUDENT CONGRESS ACT; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SHORT TITLE. -- This act may be cited as the Section 1. "Student Congress Act".

PURPOSE. -- The purpose of the Student Congress Section 2. Act is to enable youths in New Mexico to learn about the operation of the legislature first-hand by observing and participating in the interim legislative process and hearing from prominent state leaders on the functions of state government.

Section 3. PLACEMENT OF STUDENTS. --

1	A. Each legislator in the house of representatives					
2	and in the senate may select a student who is at least a					
3	sophomore in high school to participate in the student					
4	congress program during the interims prior to sixty-day					
5	sessi ons.					
6	B. Students shall have the opportunity to assist					
7	and observe an interim legislative committee and attend					
8	seminars at the state capitol, where legislative leaders shall					
9	address youth on:					

- (1) the legislative process;
- (2) current issues the legislature may be examining through the interim committee process;
 - (3) leadership training; and
- (4) other areas of interest, as determined by the legislative leadership.
- C. The chief clerk of the senate and the chief clerk of the house of representatives shall coordinate and administer the program.
- D. Students traveling from various points around the state shall be reimbursed for travel to and from interim legislative committee meetings and the state capitol.
- Section 4. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the legislative council service for expenditure in fiscal year 1999 to reimburse students participating in the .121759.1

student congress program for travel expenses and to reimburse the chief clerk of the senate and the chief clerk of the house of representatives for administrative costs associated with the program. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund.
