## AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A YEAR-LONG MENTORSHIP PROGRAM LOCATED IN ALBUQUERQUE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state department of public education for expenditure in fiscal year 1999 for the purpose of funding a year-long youth mentorship program in Albuquerque that allows students to participate in the arts, sciences and humanities. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund.
