AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR OPERATIONAL EXPENSES TO ASSIST ELIGIBLE PROGRAMS PROVIDING PRIMARY HEALTH CARE SERVICES PURSUANT TO THE RURAL PRIMARY HEALTH CARE ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Three million dollars

(\$3,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the department of health for expenditure in fiscal year 1999 for operational expenses to assist eligible programs providing primary health care services pursuant to the Rural Primary Health Care Act. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall not revert to the general fund but shall remain in departmental balances to be expended for the purposes of the Rural Primary Health Care
