16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	Section 1. Section 27-2-12.6 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1994,
18	Chapter 62, Section 22) is amended to read:
19	"27-2-12.6. MEDICAID PAYMENTSMANAGED CARE
20	A. <u>Except as provided in Subsection D of this</u>
21	section, the department shall provide for a statewide, managed
22	care system to provide cost-efficient, preventive, primary and
23	acute care for medicaid recipients by July 1, 1995.
24	B. The managed care system shall ensure:
25	(1) access to medically necessary services,
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1	particularly for medicaid recipients with chronic health				
2	problems;				
3	(2) to the extent practicable, maintenance of				
4	the rural primary care delivery infrastructure;				
5	(3) that the department's approach is				
6	consistent with national and state health care reform				
7	principles; and				
8	(4) to the maximum extent possible, that				
9	medicaid-eligible individuals are not identified as such				
10	except as necessary for billing purposes.				
11	C. The department may <u>from the provisions of this</u>				
12	<u>section</u> exclude nursing homes, [intermediate care facilities				
13	for the mentally retarded,] medicaid in-home and				
14	community-based waiver services and residential and				
15	community-based mental health services for children with				
16	serious emotional disorders [from the provisions of this				
17	section].				
18	D. The department shall exclude from the				
19	provisions of this section intermediate care facilities for				
20	the mentally retarded, developmental disability in-home and				
21	<u>community-based medicaid waiver services, developmental</u>				
22	disability early intervention services, development disability				
23	early intervention case management services and development				
24	disability state general fund services for children and				
25	<u>adults.</u> "				

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1	Section 2. APPROPRIATIONTwenty-five thousand dollars
2	(\$25,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the human
3	services department for expenditure in fiscal year 1999 for
4	the purpose of contracting with a statewide developmental
5	disabilities community provider association located in
6	Bernalillo county to conduct and complete, prior to the 1999
7	legislative session, an assessment of community-based
8	developmental disability managed care programs operated in
9	other states. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance
10	remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the
11	general fund.
