AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES; REQUIRING THE ISSUANCE OF DRIVER'S LICENSES BY MAIL; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 66-5-21 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978, Chapter 35, Section 243, as amended) is amended to read:

"66-5-21. EXPIRATION OF LICENSE--FOUR-YEAR ISSUANCE
PERIOD.--All driver's licenses shall be issued for a period of
four years, except those provided for in Section 66-5-19 NMSA
1978 and as otherwise provided in Section 66-5-67 NMSA 1978,
and each license shall expire thirty days after the
applicant's birthday in the fourth year after the effective
date of the license. A license issued pursuant to Section
66-5-19 NMSA 1978 shall expire thirty days after the
applicant's birthday in the year in which the license expires.

Each license is renewable within ninety days prior to its expiration or at an earlier date approved by the department. The fee for the license shall be as provided in Section 66-5-44 NMSA 1978. The department [may] shall provide for renewal by mail pursuant to rules adopted by the department and may require an examination upon renewal of the driver's license."

Section 2. APPROPRIATION. -- Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the motor vehicle division of the taxation and revenue department for expenditure in fiscal year 1999 for the purpose of initiating a program providing for driver's license renewal by mail. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund.
