AN ACT

RELATING TO THE BACA LOCATION NUMBER 1; CREATING THE VALLES CALDERA PURCHASE COMMISSION TO NEGOTIATE FOR THE PURCHASE OF THE BACA LOCATION NUMBER 1 ON BEHALF OF THE STATE; PROVIDING POWERS AND DUTIES; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. VALLES CALDERA PURCHASE COMMISSION

CREATED--COMPOSITION.--

A. The "Valles Caldera purchase commission" is created. The commission shall be composed of ten members of the legislature. Five members of the house of representatives shall be appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives and five members of the senate shall be appointed by the committees' committee of the senate or, if the senate appointments are made in the interim, by the

president pro tempore of the senate after consultation with and agreement of a majority of the members of the committees' committee.

- B. Members shall be appointed from each house so as to give the two major political parties in each house the same proportional representation on the commission as prevails in each house; however, in no event shall either party have less than one member from each house on the commission. Vacancies on the commission shall be filled by appointment in the same manner as the original appointments. The chairman and vice chairman of the commission shall be elected by the commission.
- C. No action shall be taken by the commission if a majority of the total membership from either house on the commission rejects such action.
- Section 2. VALLES CALDERA PURCHASE COMMISSION-DUTIES. -- The Valles Caldera purchase commission shall:
- A. negotiate, on behalf of the state, for the purchase of the Baca location number 1, known as the Baca ranch;
- B. upon the completion of successful negotiations, certify to the secretary of finance and administration that the negotiations have been successful and that the purchase price agreed to is no higher than the appraised value. Upon receiving the certification, the secretary shall cause an amount equal to the purchase price to be transferred from the land grant permanent funds to the seller. Such amount is appropriated from the land grant permanent funds;
- C. solicit testimony, reports and other information . 123032.1

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concerning the Baca location number 1 and its potential uses and benefits; and

D. submit a report of its findings and recommendations to the legislature, including its recommendations for future uses of the Baca location number 1 that will maximize benefits to the state and its citizens.

Section 3. VALLES CALDERA PURCHASE COMMISSION--STAFF.--The staff for the Valles Caldera purchase commission shall be provided by the legislative council service.

APPROPRIATION. -- For the purpose of paying the Section 4. salaries and expenses of the technical, legal, clerical and stenographic assistants; for appraisals; for necessary equipment and supplies used in carrying out the provisions of this act; and for reimbursing the per diem and mileage expenses of the Valles Caldera purchase commission, there is appropriated to the legislative council service from the general fund the sum of forty thousand dollars (\$40,000). All or any part of this appropriation may be expended in fiscal year 1999 and succeeding Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining fiscal years. at the end of the fiscal year in which the commission submits the report pursuant to Subsection D of Section 2 of this act shall revert to the general fund. Payments from the appropriation shall be made upon vouchers signed by the director of the legislative council service or his authorized representative.

Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. -- The effective date of the . 123032. 1

provisions of this act is the later of:

A. the date the secretary of state certifies that the constitution of New Mexico has been amended as proposed by a joint resolution of the forty-third legislature, second session, entitled "A JOINT RESOLUTION PROPOSING TO AMEND THE NEW MEXICO CONSTITUTION TO AUTHORIZE AN EXPENDITURE FROM THE LAND GRANT PERMANENT FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF THE BACA LOCATION NUMBER 1, INCLUDING THE VALLES CALDERA"; or

B. the date the congress of the United States consents to the amendment of the constitution of New Mexico as proposed by the joint resolution specified in Subsection A of this section.
