## **REQUESTED BY**DEDE FELDMAN

FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN THE NORTH VALLEY AREA OF ALBUQUERQUE IN BERNALILLO COUNTY.

I request that the following capital outlay project be funded:

- to the local government division of the department of finance and administration:
- A. two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to design and construct a bicycle and pedestrian trail and to install landscaping along interstate 40 between Rio Grande and Sixth streets in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;
- B. seventy-seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$77,500) to renovate the building and parking lot at the Los Duranes community center in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;
- C. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to renovate Columbus park to implement physical solutions to crime prevention and improve recreational facilities in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;
- D. seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to design and renovate Goodrich park in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;
- E. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to design and construct Dulcinea park in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county; and
- F. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for planning for construction, to include a traffic impact study, for the extension of Aspen avenue through the Sawmill redevelopment project in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

• to the department of environment:

two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for sewer systems and hook-ups in the Dietz Farms area of the north valley of Albuquerque in Bernalillo county.
