CAPITAL PROJECTS FOR POJOAQUE VALLEY SCHOOLS IN SANTA FE COUNTY.

I request that the following capital outlay projects be funded:

- to the state department of public education:
 one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to complete construction of the new high school in Pojoaque in Santa Fe county;
- to the state highway and transportation department:
- A. one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to plan and design an entry road to the Jacona campus of Pojoaque Valley schools in Santa Fe county;
- B. two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to complete the road to the central administration office of the Pojoaque Valley schools in Santa Fe county;
 - to the department of environment:
- A. seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to construct a septic holding pond at the Jacona campus of Pojoaque Valley schools in Santa Fe county;
- B. two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) to replace the water system at Pojoaque middle and high schools in Santa Fe county.
 - to the local government division of the department of finance and administration: one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) to install lighting for track and football fields at Pojoaque Valley schools in Santa Fe county.
