I request that the following capital outlay projects be funded:

- C. four hundred thirty-one thousand three hundred dollars (\$431,300) for capital improvements at Cuba independent schools in Sandoval county;
- D. twenty-five thousand eight hundred dollars (\$25,800) for capital improvements at Farmington municipal schools in San Juan county;
- E. seven million three hundred sixty-two thousand seven hundred dollars (\$7,362,700) for capital improvements at Gallup-McKinley county public schools in McKinley county;
